### \* Considerations \*

- 1) Most Minnesota teams (C & D) have not been competitive in national tournament play.
- 2) Class E has been added at the national level.
- 3) Above adjustments are necessitated to permit MN teams to be more competitive at National level and take advantage of new national class E.
- 4) Any MN team that went 2-2 or better in 2008 ASA National Tournament play must remain in same class they were in 2008 unless they were moved up by the National ASA rules.
