RE: Reclassification of Touch Football Teams

By action of the Sports Federation Board of Directors and in accordance with reclassification rules, the below teams have been reclassified for the 2010 touch football season. This has been done in effort to achieve and maintain parity within classes and balance the number of teams in classes statewide.

This process occurs on an annual basis. Teams need to be constantly challenged to compete against opponents of equal or greater strength. **"Winning isn't everything, but striving to win is"**. League directors need to promote and reinforce this philosophy.

Teams which have been moved up may not petition for a **minimum of two years** unless they have less than five returning players from the previous years team roster or they have been moved from "B" to "A".
