On the reverse side is a flyer inviting your team to participate in the 35th annual Minnesota Sports Federation Winter Outdoor Broomball State Championships/State Indoor Tournament Qualifier.

Participating teams will have an opportunity to qualify to advance to state indoor tournament play and also benefit by playing in the premier outdoor broomball tournament in Minnesota. Specifically, teams finishing first or second in their class will advance directly to 2012 state indoor tournament play. One-half the entry fee for championship team will be waived and if the team gains a paid berth through their league they will receive a check for \$100.00 (paid berth must be verified by league director.) Tournaments will be conducted in a round robin championship/consolation format guaranteeing teams plenty of playing time.

The outdoor state championship trophies which are awarded are of distinction and top quality.

Round Robin Pool Play - Three Game Minimum Guarantee. **(Note:** Should insufficient numbers exist to conduct a specific class of play (four-five or more) the MSF reserves the right to cancel that class or combine classes and utilize a "seeding method" which will assure that teams of like classification meet in separate championship play brackets.)

ENTRY DEADLINE:

Friday, January 13, 2012

ELIGIBILITY:

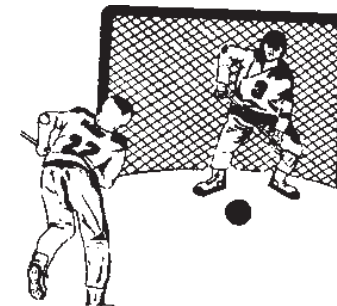
Open to any team currently rostered participating in an organized league. Teams must enter the class in which they have been designated by their league director or state broomball committee. (State broomball committee takes precedence over league class). **(subject to review by the Sports Federation).**

ROSTER LIMIT:

-17 players - must match regular season roster
Three Pick-Ups from same class or below allowed, but pickups are not permitted to play at state tournament

AWARDS:

Trophies will be presented to the first, second and third place finishers in tournaments of eight or more teams and first and second place in tournaments of seven or less teams. In addition to the above awards the championship and runnerup teams in each division and class of play will receive automatic entry into the respective 2012 indoor state tournament. One-half the entry fee is waived for championship and runner-up team in classes/divisions of 16 teams or more and one one-half paid berth in classes/divisions of less than 16 teams. If the team gains a **paid** berth through their league they will receive a check for \$100.00. (As a result this will allow your league to send more teams to state championship play than would have otherwise been possible.) **Teams winning berths that emanate from leagues which are not currently MSF registered must register the teams in their league in order to utilize the at-large berth.**
